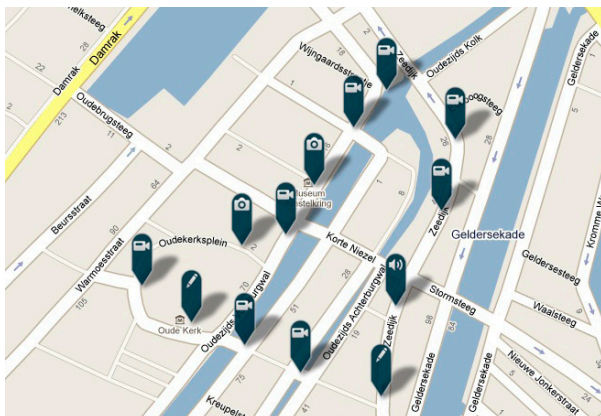

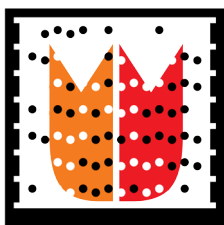

Willet-Holthuysen tour

The tour of the Amsterdam Historical Museum takes place in the neighborhood of the former residence of the well-to-do, nineteenth century couple Willet-Holthuysen on the Herengracht 605. The house in which the Willets lived is now a museum, where the art collection of Willet is the centerpiece. Walking the tour, you will get to know everything about the nineteenth century life of the Willets and the rise of the entertainment area and the fashion stores surrounding the Amstelstraat and Kalverstraat.
