Make your own wooden tablet or smartphone to prototype your app ideas in a very early stage. Great for concept presentations.

Used in the Make the Future workshops for UNDP (United Nations Development Programme) in Georgia, Egypt and Armenia, developed by Waag Society. For ideas and instructions on hands-on prototyping in design workshops, download the free Make the Future - workshop toolkit.

Material & tools:

- 4 mm plywood (960x460mm)
- wood glue
- glueing clamps

Lasercutter settings:

- select 'vector'
- select 'driver/extend' in order to cut out the full file length of 895 mm
- For cutting select pen Black: speed 2 - power 100
- For engraving select pen Red: speed 20 - power 100
